Responsible Person

We fully understand the role of the Responsible Person within Cosmetic Regulation 1223/2009 and can adopt that position for a brand or manufacturer. Alternatively we can advise clients on the actions necessary if they wish to act as RP for their own products. Portal Notifications

An essential part of EU compliance, which is frequently the beginning of the process. The Cosmetic Product Notification Portal (CPNP) is normally the first port of call for a Competent Authority if they are investigating a product, so it is essential notifications are both correct and complete.

Product Information File (PIF) Compilation & Maintenance

The Cosmetic Regulation details exactly what a PIF should comprise of, and with these documents extending to 500 pages or more in length, it is essential they are compiled and held in a manner that not only meets the requirement of the Regulation, but enables a Competent Authority to access information quickly and easily. Labelling

All personal care & cosmetic products placed on the EU market must have compliant labelling and packaging.
